

Fundraising Ideas for Congregations



1. Use Legos to build a bridge. Under the bridge you can have a paper pond with fish on which are listed all the ways World Hunger helps. Give folks a certain number of bricks per donation.
2. For large display, build a bridge using covered tissue boxes.
3. If someone in the congregation actually has a small garden bridge, bring that in and set it up again over a "pond" with all the ways World Hunger helps listed on paper fish or some other creative way. People get to walk over the bridge to deposit their donations in a receptacle.
4. BUILD a bridge and when finished, put it in your church's garden. Determine how much per plank. Obviously this one needs some creative carpenters to organize.
5. Paint a troubled water big poster (Oriental Trading has a big backdrop for \$15.99 for an idea). Jumping fish could have world hunger issues written on them. Have a fish net nearby. Each time an amount (determined by congregation) is donated, take a fish out of the sea and put it in the net!
