## **Position Description**

## **Qualities and Eligibility**

Nominees for the Synod Council should be deeply committed to the life and ministry of Christ's Church, especially as expressed through the Upstate New York Synod of the Evangelical

Lutheran Church in America, regular in their worship attendance, and charitable with their gifts of time, talent, and treasure. Each person elected to the Synod Council shall be a voting member of a congregation of this synod, with the exception of ordained ministers on the roster of this synod who reside outside the territory of this synod.

#### Nomination, Election, and Term of Office

Conferences nominate for election by the Synod Assembly lay and clergy members to the Synod Council to terms of four years in accordance with the bylaws of this synod. Additional nominations may not be made from the floor of the Synod Assembly. Background checks and screening shall be required and completed for persons nominated to the Synod Council prior to their election, if possible, or as soon as practical after their election. Members of the Synod Council are eligible for nomination and election to no more than two consecutive terms. The term of office for members of the Synod Council commences at the close of the Synod Assembly at which they were elected.

#### **Functions**

The Synod Council functions as the board of directors of this synod and serves as its interim legislative authority between meetings of the Synod Assembly. The functions of the Synod Council include:

- Exercise trusteeship responsibilities on behalf of this synod.
- Recommend program goals and fiscal proposals to the regular meetings of the Synod Assembly.
- Carry out the resolutions of the Synod Assembly.
- Provide for an annual review of the roster of ordained ministers and of other official rosters.
- Receive and act upon appropriate recommendations regarding those persons whose status is subject to reconsideration and action under the constitution and bylaws of the ELCA.
- Issue letters of call to ordained Ministers of Word and Sacrament and letters of call to Ministers of Word and Service, as authorized by the constitution and bylaws of the ELCA.
- Report its actions to the regular meeting of the Synod Assembly.
- Perform such other functions as are set forth in the bylaws of this synod, or as may be designated to it by the Synod Assembly.

## Responsibilities

Synod Council members must prepare for, attend and participate in regular and special meetings of the Synod Council and the Synod Assembly. In so doing, they must:

- Study carefully the issues on the agenda of the Synod Council.
- Listen to and participate thoughtfully in debate during meetings.

- Examine wisely possible amendments to proposals.
- Consider with insight resolutions or new business.
- Nominate and elect with care apt persons to serve on the boards and committees of this synod.
- Seek prayerfully the guidance of God's Spirit in all matters, and act conscientiously for the sake of the unity and well-being of this synod, this church and the whole Church.

### **Privileges and Accountability**

A member of the Synod Council:

- Serves as a voting member of the Synod Assembly with the privilege of voice and vote.
- May serve on committees of this synod as appointed or elected.
- May serve on their conference's executive committee, according to the custom and discretion of their respective conference.
- Is accountable to the synodical vice president in consultation with the bishop and deans.

#### Other

- Nominees for Synod Council should preferably have experience functioning in board, council, or committee settings. Previous leadership in these capacities is highly desirable.
- No elected member of the Synod Council shall receive compensation for such service.
- Synod Council members are financially responsible for a portion of the expenses associated with their attending meetings of the Synod Council and the Synod Assembly.

#### **B. SYNOD COMMITTEE ON DISCIPLINE MEMBER**

- We currently have twelve (12) members that comprise a 50/50 clergy/lay split.
- There are four (4) positions that will be available for the Synod Discipline Committee, due to term limits.
  - They are two (2) Rostered Ministers and two (2) Lay persons.
- The term for this position is six (6) years.
- Members whose terms are coming to conclusion are not eligible for re-election.
- Nominations can be received from the floor of the Synod Assembly
- Persons who are nominated, should complete the Nominations form that has been provided, so that information is published in the 2024 Synod Assembly, Pre-Assembly booklet.
- Voting for these seats may be by written ballot (dependent upon number of nominations)

## **Position Description**

## Qualities and Eligibility

Nominees for the Synod Committee on Discipline should be deeply committed to the life and ministry of Christ's Church, especially as expressed through the Upstate New York Synod of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America, regular in their worship attendance, and charitable with their gifts of time, talent, and treasure.

Each person elected to the Committee on Discipline shall be a voting member of a congregation of this synod.

## Nomination, Election, and Term of Office

The Nominating Committee of the Synod Council nominates clergy and lay members for election by the Synod Assembly to the Synod Committee on Discipline. Additional nominations may be made from the floor of the Synod Assembly.

A member of the Committee on Discipline serves for one term of six years and is not eligible for consecutive reelection. The term of service for members of the Committee on Discipline commences at the close of the Synod Assembly at which they were elected.

## **Functions and Responsibilities**

The Committee on Discipline, consisting of six clergy and six lay members, serves to render decisions in matters referred to it by the Synod Consultation Committee concerning formal ecclesiastical discipline involving a rostered person or a congregation.

When such matters are referred, a panel is formed of three clergy and three lay members from the Synod Committee on Discipline, appointed by the synodical vice president, and six members of the Churchwide Committee of Discipline appointed by the vice president of the ELCA. This panel meets with and hears from the parties involved in the matter and renders a decision. If the allegations are sustained, the panel will impose a discipline appropriate to the situation.

## **Privileges and Accountability**

- Persons elected to the Committee on Discipline may simultaneously serve on other structures of the synod if they are so selected or elected.
- The Committee on Discipline is accountable to the synodical vice president, the vice president of the ELCA, and the synodical bishop.

#### Other

- Nominees for the Committee on Discipline should be persons of maturity and good judgment, who can function with discretion and fairness, and able to handle confidential information.
- The bishop of the synod is not a member of the Committee on Discipline.

#### C. CONSULTATION COMMITTEE

- We currently have eight (8) members that comprise a 50/50 clergy/lay split.
- There are four (4) positions that will be available for the Synod Consultation Committee due to term limits.
  - They are two (2) Rostered Ministers and two (2) Lay persons.
  - In addition, there are two (2) additional Lay person positions available due vacancies, and two (2) additional Rostered Minister positions available due to vacancies.
  - That brings a total of four (4) positions (4 Rostered Ministers, four (4) Lay persons) available for nomination and eventual election.
- The term for this position is six (6) years.
- Members whose terms are coming to conclusion are not eligible for re-election.
- Nominations can be received from the floor of the Synod Assembly
- Persons who are nominated, should complete the Nominations form that has been provided, so that information is published in the 2024 Synod Assembly, Pre-Assembly booklet.
- Voting for these seats may be by written ballot (dependent upon number of nominations

## **Qualities and Eligibility**

Nominees for the Synod Consultation Committee should be deeply committed to the life and ministry of Christ's Church, especially as expressed through the Upstate New York Synod of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America, regular in their worship attendance, and charitable with their gifts of time, talent, and treasure.

Each person elected to the Consultation Committee shall be a voting member of a congregation of this synod.

## Nomination, Election, and Term of Office

The Nominating Committee of the Synod Council nominates clergy and lay members for election by the Synod Assembly to the Synod Consultation Committee. Additional nominations may be made from the floor of the Synod Assembly.

A member of the Consultation Committee serves for one term of six years and is not eligible for consecutive reelection. The term of service for members of the Consultation Committee commences at the close of the Synod Assembly at which they were elected.

#### **Functions and Responsibilities**

The Consultation Committee, consisting of six clergy and six lay members, serves primarily in an advisory role to the office of the synodical bishop and assists the bishop to investigate situations that are potentially matters of formal ecclesiastical discipline of a rostered person or a congregation. When such a situation arises, the Synod Council appoints from this committee three ordained and two lay members to serve as a special Consultation Committee to consider the issue.

The special Consultation Committee meets with the parties involved in an effort to resolve the situation. If, as a result of the consultation, the allegations are withdrawn, no further proceeding is required. Otherwise, the special Consultation Committee must then submit a written report to either the synodical bishop or the Committee on Discipline depending on whether disciplinary action may result.

## **Privileges and Accountability**

- Persons elected to the Consultation Committee may simultaneously serve on other structures of the synod if they are so selected or elected.
- The Consultation Committee meets at the request of and is accountable to the office of the bishop.
- The bishop of the synod shall be a member of the Consultation Committee in addition to the twelve elected members

#### Other

- Nominees for the Consultation Committee should be persons of maturity and good judgment, who can function with discretion and fairness, and are able to handle confidential information.
- The bishop of the synod shall be a member of the Consultation Committee in addition to the twelve elected members.

#### D. CHURCHWIDE ASSEMBLY VOTING MEMBER

- We are allocated 10 voting members by the ELCA formula, 6 lay and 4 clergy/deacons
- The breakdown is as follows:
  - 1 Bishop, male, clergy
  - 1 Synod Vice President, male
  - o 3 Clergy/Deacon (one male and two female, or two male and one female)
  - $\circ$  5 Lay (two male, three female)
    - A minimum of one of the ten above must be a person of color or whose primary language is other than English.
    - A minimum of one of the ten must be a youth or young adult (attained the age of 18) at the time of election.
- We also are allocated one each *additional* voting member seat for a person of color or whose primary language is other than English, *and* one additional youth/young adult. These may be lay or clergy/deacon, except if a youth is elected, they are by default lay.
- Voting for these positions will be conducted throughout the Synod Assembly. Voting may be by written ballot, dependent upon the number of nominations received for each position.

## **Position Description**

## **Qualities and Eligibility**

Nominees for voting member of the ELCA Churchwide Assembly should be deeply committed to the life and ministry of Christ's Church, especially as expressed through the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America and the Upstate New York Synod, regular in their worship attendance, and charitable with their gifts of time, talent, and treasure.

Each person elected to serve as a Churchwide Assembly voting member shall be a voting member of a congregation of this synod.

## Nomination, Election, and Term of Service

Each triennium, conferences nominate individuals for election by the Synod Assembly as voting members of the Churchwide Assembly in accordance with the bylaws of this church and guidelines set forth by the Synod Council. Elected voting members serve in their role at the Churchwide Assembly next occurring following their election.

#### **Functions**

Voting members of ELCA congregations gather triennially to serve in the Churchwide Assembly as representatives not only of their own congregations and synods but also on behalf of all the people of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America. Nourished by Word and Sacrament, they are called in assembly to make decisions and seek the well-being of this whole church.

## Responsibility of the Assembly

The Churchwide Assembly is the highest legislative authority in the ELCA. The assembly deals with the purposes, functions, and directions of churchwide ministries, and addresses issues that affect the life of our whole church.

The Churchwide Assembly must:

- Review the work of the churchwide officers, receive reports from them and act on business proposed by them.
- Review the work of the churchwide units, receive reports from them and act on business proposed by them.
- Receive and consider proposals from synod assemblies.
- Establish churchwide policy.
- Adopt a budget for the churchwide organization.
- Elect officers, board members, and other persons as provided in the constitution and bylaws.
- Establish churchwide units to carry out the functions of the churchwide organization.
- Have the sole authority to amend the constitution and bylaws. Fulfill other functions as required in the constitution and bylaws.
- Conduct such other business as necessary to further the purposes and functions of the churchwide organization.

## Responsibilities

Voting members individual responsibilities are to:

- Attend the 2025 ELCA Churchwide Assembly held July 28 through August 2, 2025, in Phoenix, Arizona.
- Represent the interests of this whole church to facilitate its mission and ministry.
- Seek the guidance of the Holy Spirit and approach the Churchwide Assembly's work with reflection and prayer.
- Participate in orientation, both that provided by the synod and that provided by the churchwide organization.
- Be present during the entire Churchwide Assembly, attending plenary sessions, worship, hearings, and other assembly-related activities.
- Study in advance the Pre-Assembly Report, particularly the reports of officers and the matters on which the Churchwide Assembly will take action.
- Listen to presentations and discussion and be prepared to participate responsibly.
- Exemplify servant leadership in words, life-style, and manner of leadership, recognizing accountability to the Triune God, the whole Church, each other, and to the Churchwide Assembly as a whole.
- Provide reports about the Churchwide Assembly to congregations and others within the synod.

#### Other

- Nominees for Churchwide Assembly voting member must be available to attend the scheduled Churchwide assembly, typically over five days during the month of August.
- Nominees should preferably have experience functioning in board, council, or committee settings. A basic understanding of Parliamentary Procedure is helpful.
- Voting members attend an assembly orientation workshop held at a central location in Upstate New York.
- The bishop of this synod is an ex officio voting member of the Churchwide Assembly.
- The vice president of this synod serves as a voting member of the Churchwide Assembly.
- No elected voting member of the Churchwide Assembly shall receive compensation for such service.

Expenses associated with serving as a Churchwide Assembly voting member are substantially covered by the ELCA. Voting members may be personally responsible for certain incidental expenses.


